## RESULTS ON THE INDIVIDUAL LEVEL



### SENDING ORGANISATIONS:

*On the individual level we strengthened the competences that will help young people in the process of inclusion into the society and increase their employment possibilities. We enhanced the personality development of young people through the empowerment based on non-formal learning and positive experiences. We can describe the results on the individual level as:*

- increased daily practical skills and readiness for independent life
- more positive self esteem
- improvement of different social skills (communication skills, conflict solving, capacity for empathy, politeness...)
- growth of self-initiativness
- volunteers discovered new interests and many got inspired for their future professional careers
- stronger motivation and responsibility to work
- readiness for the team work and for the work in the intercultural environment
- improvement of time management and budgetting skills
- improved ability and more self confidence to communicate in English
- basic experiences to work with children
- new technical and gardening knowledge
- knowledge about environment friendly life
- new intercultural knowledge, decrease of the xenophobia, stereotypes and prejudices, change of attitude and perspective towards new and unfamiliar
- by being foreigners in another country the volunteers recognized their European identity and are going to understand their role as European citizens better.

*The experience of living and working in a foreign environment boosted the feeling of independence and will motivate the volunteers to search for something better for their future either in their home country or abroad. Some volunteers started to look for a long term project.*

- based on the good experiences of this project we continue our partnership and we will developed new short term EVS projects.

*For the Georgian organisation »Droni«, for the Macedonian organisation »Krik« and for the Belgian organisation »Cirkus in beweging« this was the first experience with hosting Slovene volunteers with fewer opportunities. They managed to support the volunteers well and everything went smoothly. The organisations have learned a lot and their motivation to continue with hosting increased.*

*This project not only allowed the partners to strenghten the partnership among them, but also gave the opportunities to the partners as well as the young volunteers to promote the values of non-formal education and youth work, being "a living proof" of the effects that European mobility projects can have on the organizations, young people and local communities. The project contributed to the development of non-formal education and the promotion of its recognition as a tool for the development of skills and competences for young people with fewer opportunities. It facilitated their integration or re-integration into the educational system or the labour market. The project was based on the values of democracy and mutual respect and spreaded these values into the local, regional and European society.*
